Brandon Dermody became Managing Partner of The Southern Group's South Carolina office in 2005. Prior to joining Southern, Brandon started The Harrell Group and served as owner/president from 2003-2005.

During his tenure at Southern, Brandon successfully secured a \$9 million loan to help save the U.S.S. Laffey, the most decorated naval destroyer in the history of the U.S. Navy.

Currently, Brandon serves on numerous boards and commissions, including the Coastal Carolina Fair and the South Carolina Junior Tennis Foundation, as well as the advisory council for the Lowcountry March of Dimes. Brandon has been a guest lecturer at the University of Pennsylvania's Fels School of Government and LaSalle University's political science department. Brandon also served as Honorary Commander for the USAF 14th Airlift Squadron at the Charleston Air Force Base, and after two years of service, he was asked to join the Charleston Air Force Base Commander's Advisory Board. In 2009, Brandon was invited to attend the National Security Forum at the prestigious Air Force War College in Montgomery, Alabama.

Brandon received a BA in political science and a minor in Russian linguistics from Florida State University and studied abroad at St. Petersburg University in Russia.
